In recent years, scientific evidence for treating disease is unravelled by identifying active bio-component in these herbal formulations. First such compound identified and extended for therapeutic uses was acetyl salicylic acid, which is widely used over the years as a pain killer. Likewise, vincristine, quinine and very recently artemisia are extracted from plants. Use of plant bio-actives apart from their success as therapeutic agents is widely used as preventive medicine. The list of compounds belongs to flavonoids, polyphenolics, isoflavones and glycosides. These compounds exhibit their activities as antioxidants, anti-inflammatory, antimicrobial, anti-cancerous, anti-diabetic or in treating Parkinson's or Alzheimer's disease.
